




It's an event filled with surprises, innovations and awe-inspiring sights. We're talking gardens in the sky, an Emirati opera and one of the world's largest 360-degree



GETTING TO AND FROM EXPO

There are a variety of ways to get to Expo 2020. Whether you have a car or prefer to take public transport, your journey to Expo 2020 will be seamless.



By Dubai Metro

This is the most sustainable way to get to the event. The Dubai Metro takes you from the city of Dubai to the entrance of Expo 2020 at the Dubai Exhibition Centre and Al Wasl Gate. During peak hours, on average, wait times will not exceed three minutes.

By Expo Rider buses

where it drops you off as you will have to take the return trip from the same Expo Rider stop.

By taxi and e-Hail

Dubai's taxis and car hires are plentiful. Taxis can be booked by phone, but the simplest way is to download the RTA, Careem or Uber app. All taxi and e-Hail pick-ups incur a AED 20 pick-up charge for trips starting at Expo.



By car

If you are driving to the Expo 2020 site, it is accessible from all major highways. Follow the signs for one of the designated parking areas.



Parking

Parking is free of charge and available from 08:30 to 01:00, Saturday to Wednesday, and from 08:30 to 03:00, Thursday to Friday.

Sustainability Parking from the E77 Expo Road or D54 Zayed bin Hamdan al Nahyan

Mobility Parking from the E311 Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Road

Each parking area is clearly marked with its district colour to help you remember where you parked. Scan the QR code on the signs in the parking area to log where you parked your car. There is a free Parking Shuttle to take you to the nearest Expo entrance.
